

About Matt: Dr. Matt Brooks has been a Principal Investigator with the U.S. Geological Survey, Western Ecological Research Center since 1998, serving both as a Research Ecologist and a Research Botanist. His current studies in the Sierra Nevada focus on meadows and forested vegetation types with topics that include climate change, fire, plant communities, invasive species, wildlife species, and pack stock management. He has helped to author over 130 peer-reviewed publications, 1991 through 2013 inclusive. Topics include soils, vegetation, wildlife, community, ecosystem, and land use studies in the Sierra Nevada, Mojave Desert, Sonoran Desert, Great Basin, and Colorado Plateau. He also serves as Associate Editor for the journals Fire Ecology, Invasive Plant Science and Management, and Rangeland Ecology and Management.
