

About Eric: Eric Winford is an inter-disciplinary scientist working at Sequoia and Kings Canyon National Parks as an ecologist/projects facilitator. He is heavily involved in planning efforts, such as the parks' long-term Resource Stewardship Strategy, and is also working as the Sierra Nevada Fire Science coordinator. Prior to working for the park service, Eric worked as an independent environmental consultant for various firms such as The Nature Conservancy and the Sierra Nevada Conservancy, where he provided technical assistance on conservation planning and ecosystem service evaluation. He has previously worked for the John Muir Institute of the Environment at UC Davis, the Nevada Tahoe Conservation District, and the USFS -Lake Tahoe Basin Management Unit. He received a master's in geography from UC Davis in 2011 for work describing connections among Sierra Nevada forest management, wildfire, and carbon emissions.
